

# KIDS CLUB RULES

1. Based on availability, all children between the ages of 6 months – 12 years old and are in good health will be admitted to Kids Club
2. Children must be dropped off and picked up by the same parent/guardian. There are NO exceptions, unless otherwise stated on the waiver release form.
3. Parent /guardian must sign their child(ren) in and out each time they visit Kids Club.
4. Parent/guardian must remain in Kids Club until their children have entered the play area.
5. There is a 2-Hour time limit. If you exceed the 2 hours, a Kids club employee will attempt to find you.
6. The parent/guardian is encouraged to change diapers / feed their child before entering kids club. If the child(ren) need to be changed or fed, a Kids Club employee will contact you and notify you.
7. Kids Club Employees are not permitted to authorize any prescription or non-prescription medication.
8. Only Staff members are allowed in the play area unless the parent/guardian is changing a diaper or helping their child in the restroom.
9. Labeling is required on any personal items such as toys, bottles, sippy cups etc.. Kids Club is not responsible for any lost/stolen items.
10. Children will not be permitted to enter Kids Club if they have a fever, they are ill, or showing signs of any communicable diseases or conditions. The decision to admit a child is at the sole discretion of the management team. Diseases or conditions that exclude children from being admitted to Kids Club includes, but not limited to: chicken pox, diphtheria, gastroenteritis, head lice, hepatitis (Type A, impetigo, influenza, measles, meningitis, mumps, pink eye, polio, ring worm, scabies, shigellosis, strep throat, scarlet fever, tuberculosis and whooping cough.
11. We will make every effort to comfort a crying child. When a child cannot be calmed down within 15 minutes, the parent may be retrieved to assist in comforting the child.
12. Children who are not responsive to kids club attendants attempting to detour disruptive behavior ( including, but not limited to: hitting , pushing, biting, fighting, abusive language, throwing toys) will need to be removed by their parents/guardians from the Kids Club area.
13. Staff will communicate with parents and keep informed of their child(ren) behaviors. If there is an incident, parents will be notified upon pick-up. If your child's behavior is excessively aggressive, causing potential harm to others, upon 3<sup>rd</sup> removal/behavior notification we will ask that your child not return to Kids Club until behavior is corrected.
14. If your child is injured while Kids Club, an incident report will be filled out by Kids Club staff and signed by a supervisor/manager and the parent/guardian.
15. In case of serious injury, the parent will be notified immediately. 911 will be called if necessary.
16. Failure to follow the rules and regulations by the parent/guardian may lead to loss of Kids Club privileges.
